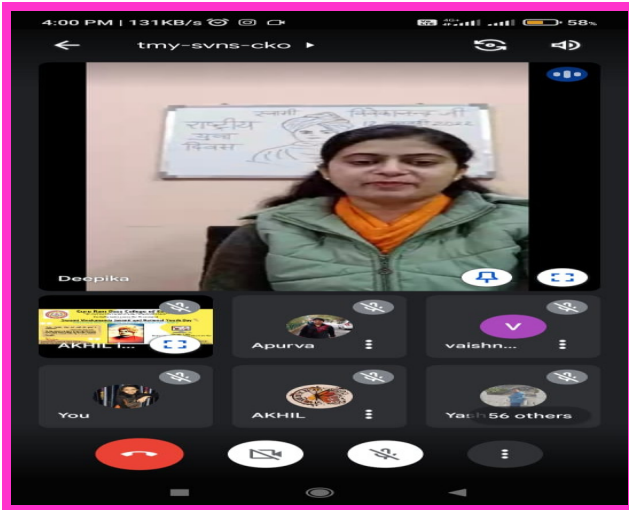
Virtual Orientation program for IV Semester – 10th January 2022

Virtual Celebration of Makar Sankranti – 14th Jan. 2022

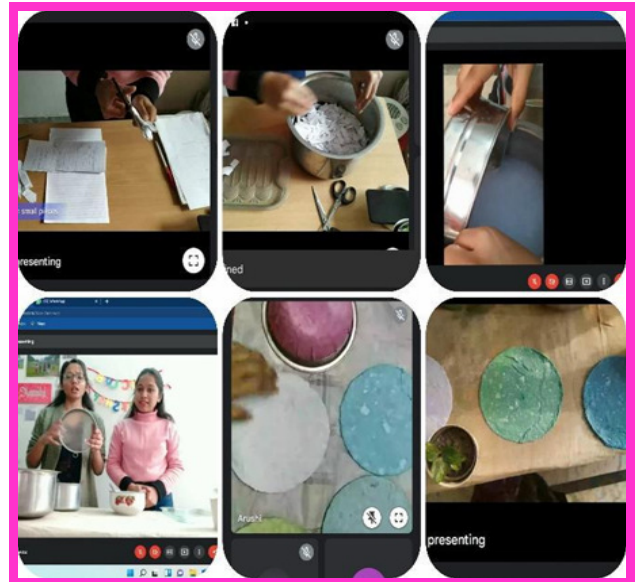

audience and the faculty members cheered on the participants.



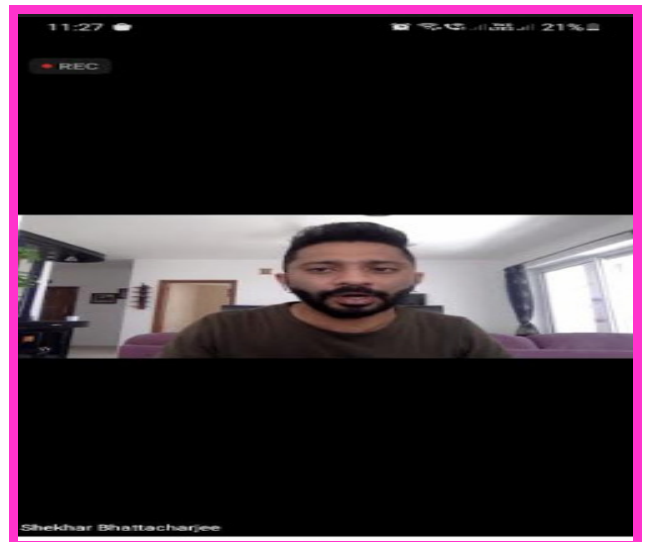
Virtual Workshop on Paper recycle - 22nd Jan. 2022

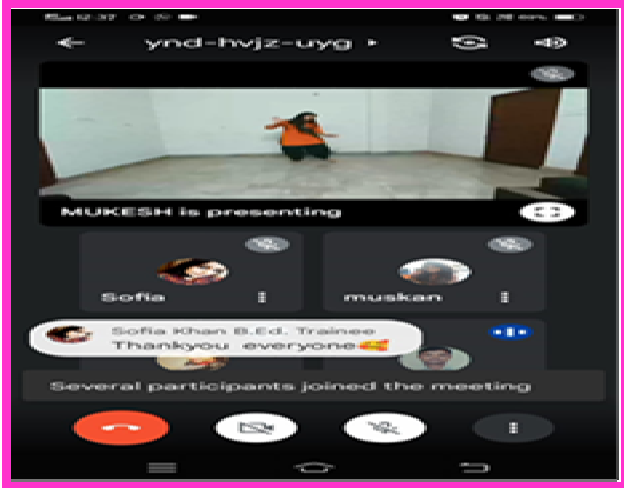
Virtual workshop on Placement and Career Guidance – 22nd January 2022

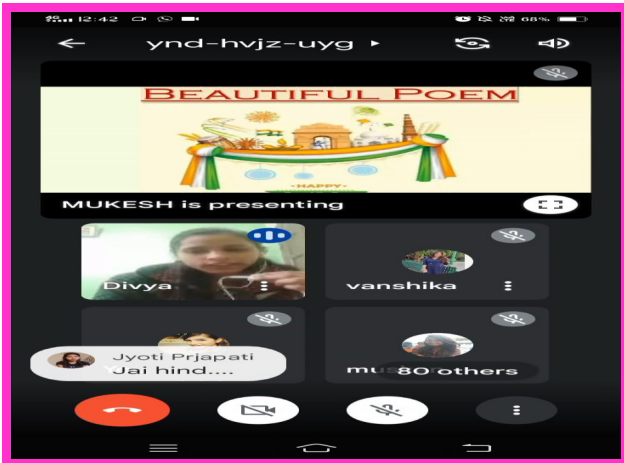


Virtual Celebration of Republic Day – 25th January 2022

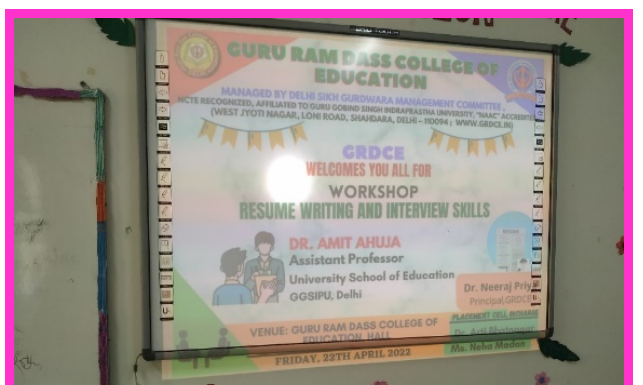

The speaker was Dr. Amit Ahuja, Assistant Professor in GGSIPU. He discussed and shared his experiences of the types of people whom he interviewed and the mistakes they made during their interviews. Two guides from Amar Jyoti School were assigned to us to explain the whole functioning of the school along with the Research and Rehabilitation Centre. Our guides accompanied us and explained the importance of Medicinal services and Theoretical interventions in the Rehabilitation Centre such as Occupational Therapy, Audiology lab, Prosthetic workshop and Physiotherapy in the school. We also viewed the dedicated rooms for the skill development and the vocational training that was provided by the Amar Jyoti inclusive school which

train the students in the area such as Jewellery making, Jute bag making, Poetry, Art and craft, Cutting and Tailoring, Bakery etc. We also visited inner compus of Amar Jyoti School from the inside where we were able to see all the classroom which was designed for inclusive education. We were also informed about special preparatory classes that were conducted for the severely lowering disabled and children with multiple disabilities to bring them to par with others. The whole purpose of the visit to the school was to make us aware of the differently able students and how to create an inclusive environment in our classrooms and schools.
