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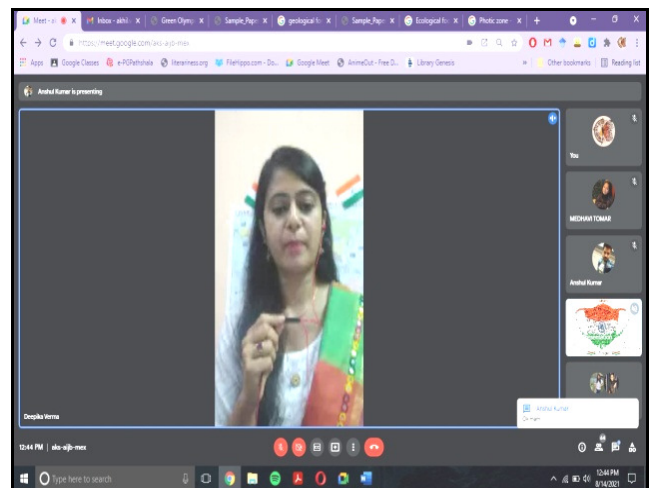
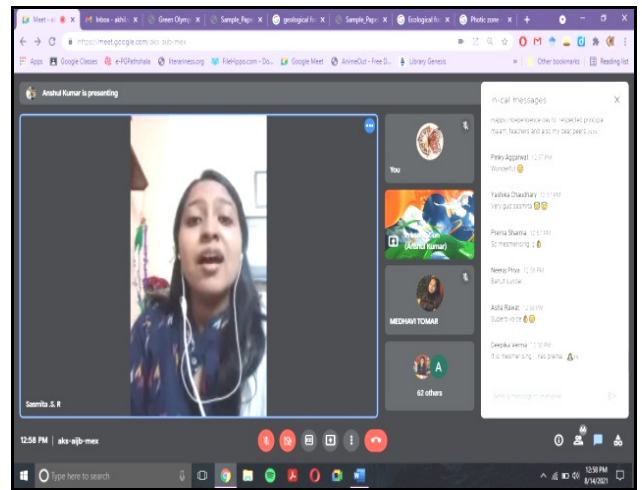


COLLEGE ACADEMIC DIARY

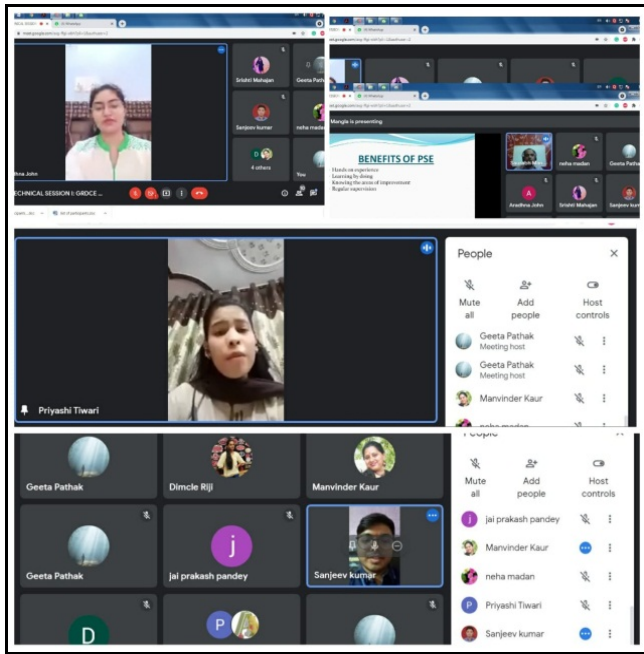

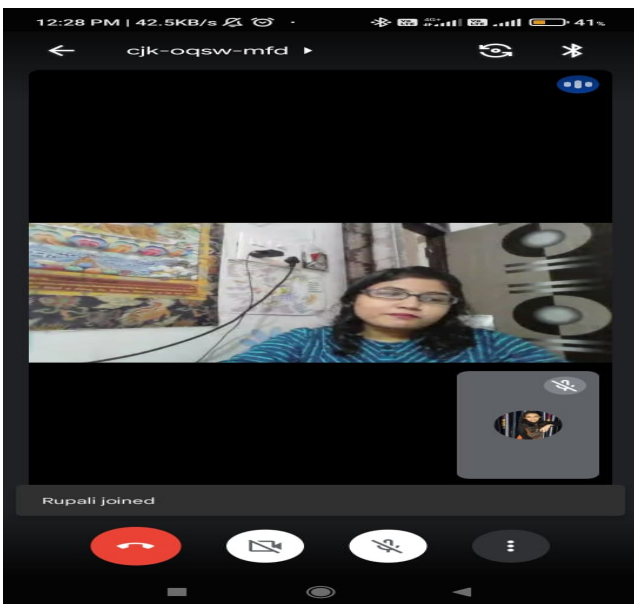
presenters who had joined us online. The Management Committee of the college also shared their own words of wisdom about the teaching of Guru Nanak Ji.



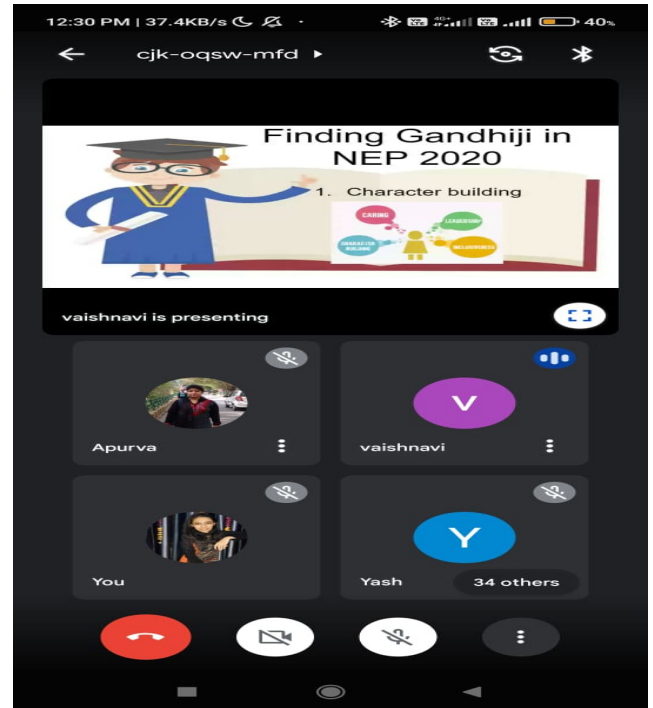

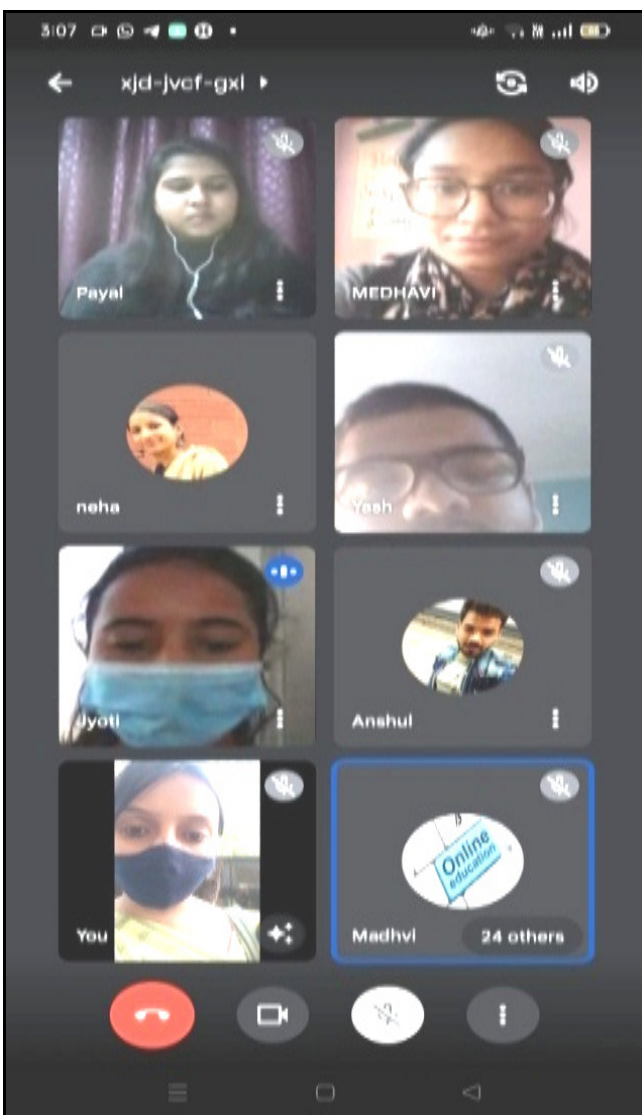


Vigilance Week - 26th Oct - 1st Nov., 2021

Parents Orientation Day - 11th December 2021

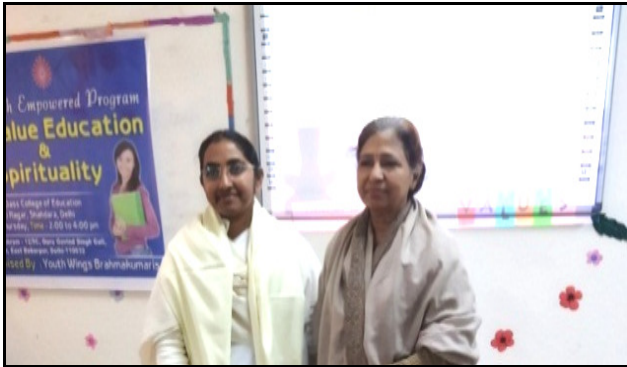

short speech about the history and heritage of the college and delivered the vote of thanks. All the students were very much excited. The entire function was a grand success.

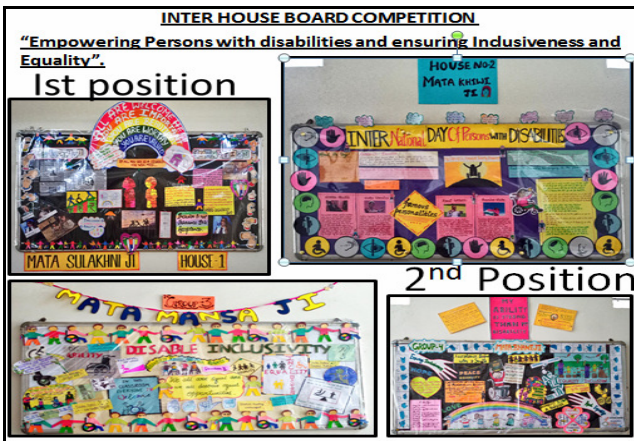


Workshop on Environment Protection – 21st December 2021
