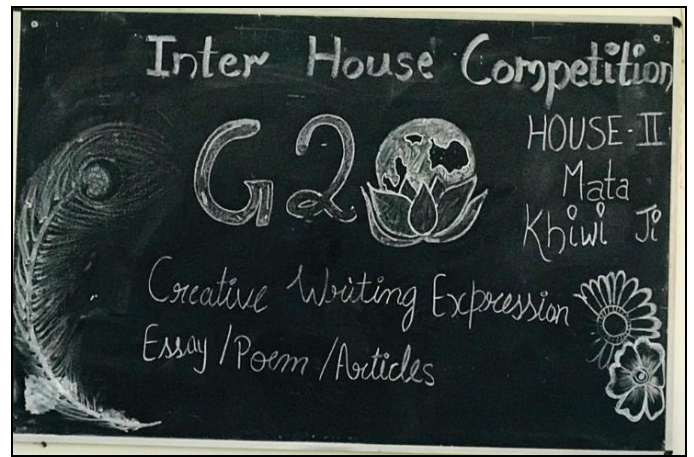
### G20-Creative Writing Expression- Essay/Poem/Articles Inter House Competition held on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2023
