

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ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The world today is facing unprecedented opportunities and challenges in their lives due to rapid advancement of science and technology. There is widespread crisis of moral and ethical values. Exploitation of a human being by another human being, religious terrorism, casteism, social apathy, economic disparities, and corruption are just a few among the many social evils that afflict us today. CONCEPT NOTE

Guru Nanak spoke of one God, universal brotherhood, love, humility, simplicity, equality and tolerance. He did not believe in the division between people based on caste, colour, religion, and race. According to him only two kinds of people exist- **Gurmukh**-the God-oriented people devoting themselves to welfare of mankind and Manmukh-those who are self-oriented and practices nothing but selfishness. In the wider sense of education Guru Nanak had highest regards for Gurmukhs who according to him were really educated persons.

The educational philosophy of Guru Nanak is focused on complete and total development of personality of students. His spirit of Simran-Meditation and Sewa-service through Naam Japna-Focus and remembrance of the almighty, Kirat Karna- honest living, Vand Chhakna-sharing and consuming together, clearly indicate towards judicious development of mind, body and soul. All this attainment of values can be achieved through philosophy of Guru Nanak.

According to Guru Nanak, education is essential for avoidance of disvalues, appropriate use of survival values, and inculcation of social and spiritual values. Almost all our problems like apathetic behavior, ill personal and intellectual degeneration can be attributed to the less or little emphasis on value development in the educational system and content.

In keeping with the philosophy and ethos of Guru Nanak's teachings, it is crucial for us today to better understand and introspect his vision and impart it to the modern youth. This Conference is being organized to sensitise all the stakeholders towards the philosophy and vision of Guru Nanak, so that it can be integrated in the present social and educational scenario.

The abstract and full paper must follow the prescribed guidelines:

- 1. Title of the paper
- 2. Main objective
- 3. Methodology
- 4. Findings (In case the study is yet not complete, the areas to be covered may be mentioned)
- 5. In theoretical papers review of literature should be mentioned.
